#### **Introduction and Overview**

Students in Year 11 will continue to follow the **AQA Specification B in Religious Education**. The modules they will be studying are **Unit 2 Religion and Life Issues** and **Unit 3 Religion and Morality**.

During Year 11 they will specifically study Religion and animal rights, Religious attitudes to rich and poor in British Society, Religious attitudes to world poverty.

#### **How to support your child**

Parents can support with homework and independent study by encouraging your child to explain to you what they have to do and talk through their homework with you.

Encourage your child to explain and justify their own viewpoints to you on the ethical issues we are studying.

Ensure that if your child misses any lessons due to absence all missed work is copied up.
