## **Year 7 Pantomime Dick Whittington at Alderford Lake**

This Christmas following the success of their summer sell out production of *The Wind in the Willows*, Immersion Theatre are thrilled to be returning to Alderford Lake to present Alderford's biggest, most spectacular and fun-filled festive treat: *Dick Whittington*!

Packed with hilarious routines, heaps of socially distanced audience interaction, and a host of chart-topping hits, this high energy, exciting story about a young man seeking his fame and fortune among the bright lights of the big city promises to be the purrrrr-fect Christmas experience!

The event takes place at Alderford Lake on Wednesday, 16 December at 1pm under the shelter of a marquee. The cost is £11 per student which is available for payment via ParentPay. Attendance at this event will be based on good lesson gradings being met. Should students be refused participation at this event a full refund will be offered.

Socially distanced in class bubbles and outdoor for safety and enjoyment this pop up panto will last approximately 90 minutes and include a 20-minute interval. Come rain or shine; the show WILL go on! Alderford will be adhering to government guidance at the time of the event. This event will only be cancelled in the event of another 'lockdown' being imposed. Should this be the case, you will be entitled to a full refund. This will also be the case in the event of any class/year bubble closure.

Travel will be by Lakeside Coach or School Minibus. All students will be allocated a seat and will travel and be seated within their own class bubble. Students will remain in their class bubbles for the whole event and will return in time for the end of the school day.

Students will need to **wear full school uniform to include appropriate clothing for outdoors i.e. layers, warm socks, hats, scarves and gloves with a sensible coat**. Students will need to **bring a packed lunch** and are welcome to bring appropriate snacks and drinks (not fizzy) to prepare themselves to cheer the goodies and boo the baddies!
